Carnival MegaPasses are \$65 in advance at select Jewel-Osco locations and \$75 during Last Fling from the Carnival Ticketing Booth near Jackson Avenue and Eagle Street.

The fun continues on Saturday, September 2 with Family-Friendly Fun at the Riverwalk Amphitheater, Food Vendors, Carnival rides and much more more!

At 8PM, is [Too Hype Crew](#), a tribute to the fun hip hop and party anthems of the 80's, through early 00's, featuring an all-live seven piece band. At 5:15PM, [90's Pop Nation](#) performs covers of the biggest pop hits, one hit wonders, sing-alongs, and dance hits while [The Prissillas](#) witty and interactive performances will have you singing along at 2:30PM! [OMT](#) takes the stage at 12PM to play their variety of music from Rock to Indie to Country-from classic to current.



Sunday, September 3 is Special Needs Day at the Last Fling Carnival with no-wait wristbands available between 10AM-2PM. [Sixteen Candles Band](#) tops the night at 8PM with their energetic and exciting concert experience which audiences won't soon forget! At 5:15PM, [The Ron Burgundy's](#) will croon soft rock from the 60s, 70s and 80s! At 2:30PM, [The Country Night](#) delivering all your favorite new country hits plus the classics! [Within 4 Days](#) will start the afternoon at 12PM with their covers of songs from artists like The Beatles, The Eagles, Zac Brown Band, Lynyrd Skynyrd, and Darius Rucker.



Ron Keller, Conductor and Music Director for the Naperville Municipal Band has been named Grand Marshal for the Last Fling Labor Day Parade which kicks off at 10AM on Monday, September 4. Following the Parade, a complimentary lunch for Veterans will take place near the Stage on Jackson Avenue where [HiInfidelity](#) caps the 2023 Last Fling; performing the biggest hits of the 80's at 3:45PM. [Rick Lindy and the Wild Ones!](#) starting at 12PM.

The Business Expo, Food and Beverage Vendors will be found along Jackson Avenue between Main and Eagle Streets. There, patrons may interact with businesses such as GradePower Learning, US Army Recruiting and World Class TKD or purchase food from Genoa Italian Concessions, Perk N Pickle LLC, Spartan Ale House and Pierogi Rig to name a few. This year, the Last Fling will offer soft drinks from Dr Pepper Snapple Group and a selection of adult beverages including but not limited to Miller, Sam Adams, Leinenkugel's, Truly, Angry Orchard, Ranch Water and Slushies from Aspen Lane Wine Company. Additionally, there will be a selection of flavors from Go-Brewing, a non-alcoholic alternative for those 21+ only. As always, the Naperville Jaycees request all patrons to celebrate responsibly.
