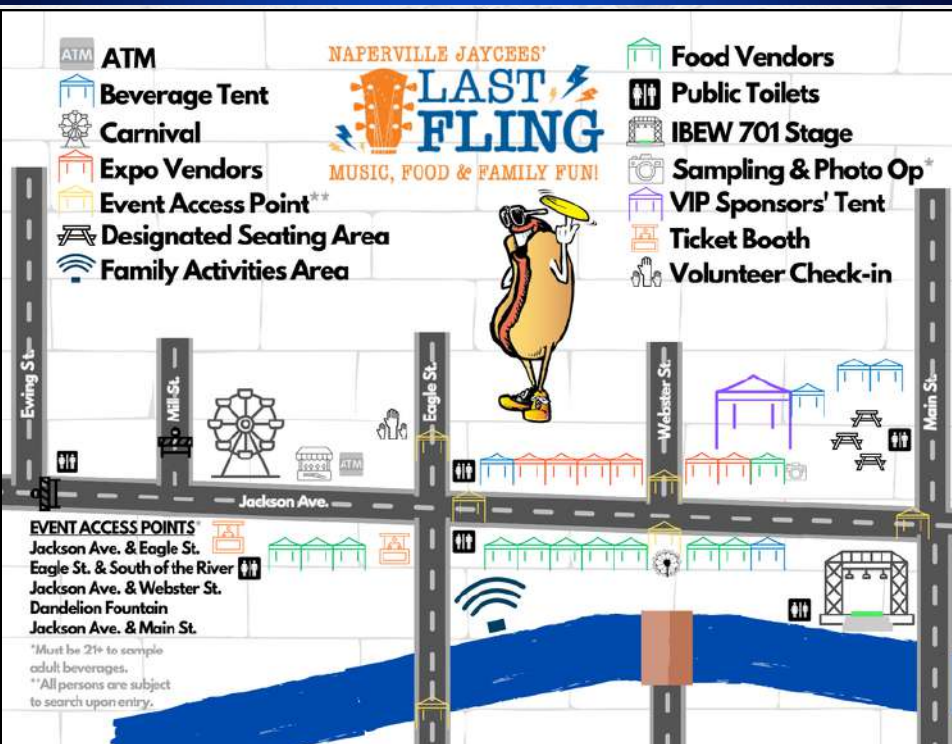

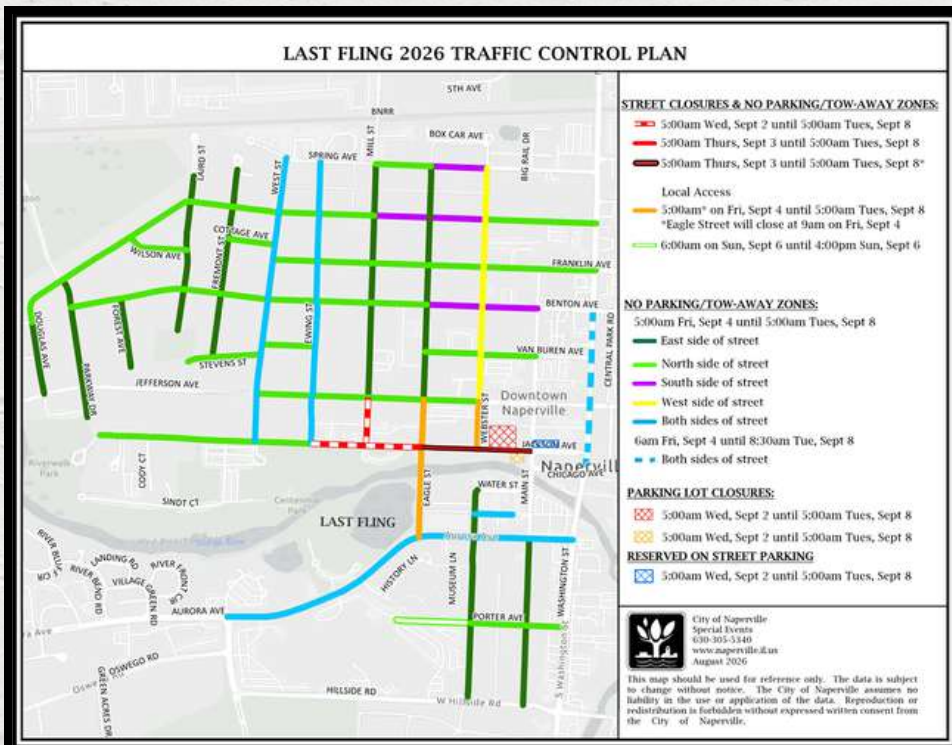

This year we're celebrating America's 250th birthday, and Naperville has been part of that story for almost 200 of those years. I think about that every time I walk

downtown during Fling weekend. Generations of families have stood on these same streets, waiting for the same parade, and in this celebratory year, that history feels almost tangible.

What I like most about the Last Fling is that there really is something here for everyone: families, students, longtime residents, visitors, and people who moved here last month. For a few days they're all downtown together, young and old, and nobody is in a hurry to be anywhere else. Music, food, a carnival, the business expo, and a parade that still draws a huge crowd every Labor Day: these are the sights and soundtracks of the weekend as we say goodbye to summer in our own unique Naperville style.

None of it happens without the Naperville Jaycees. These are volunteers. Nobody pays them to give up a piece of their summer and run the biggest multi-day event in this city. The Last Fling is their largest fundraiser, and over the years it has raised more than \$2 million for nonprofits across Naperville and DuPage County. And while you're visiting the Last Fling, you can take a short walk and enjoy where some of those dollars went, like the Jaycee Marina, the accessible playground on the Riverwalk, the gazebo at Fredenhagen Park, and Jaycees Park by the Municipal Center. That's an amazing testament to the volunteer spirit that has always been at the forefront of Naperville's success.

On behalf of the City Council and the City of Naperville, thank you to the Jaycees for putting this together again, and thank you to everyone who comes out to keep the Last Fling tradition alive!
